Community Brain Injury Services is most well known for our Clubhouse-model vocational rehabilitation programs. We operate two programs, The Mill House in Richmond, and The Denbigh House in Newport News and help individuals work on the socioemotional, cognitive, and behavioral changes following a brain injury. The Clubhouse programs also offer an array of vocational services and emphasizes the power of work.



Community Supports

Building back towards independence includes setting up the needed supports in the community to ensure health, safety, and accessibility for each individual. This looks different for each person. Our skilled case managers work with the survivor and their treatment team to put into place the appropriate resources and supports.



Strengthening Support Systems

No person should face a challenge on one's own. At CBIS it's equally important to support the caregiver and treatment team so that no one is navigating this road alone. CBIS offers Caregiver support groups and events, and embraces a team-based approach in ensuring everyone receives the supports they need.
