## THE FACTS

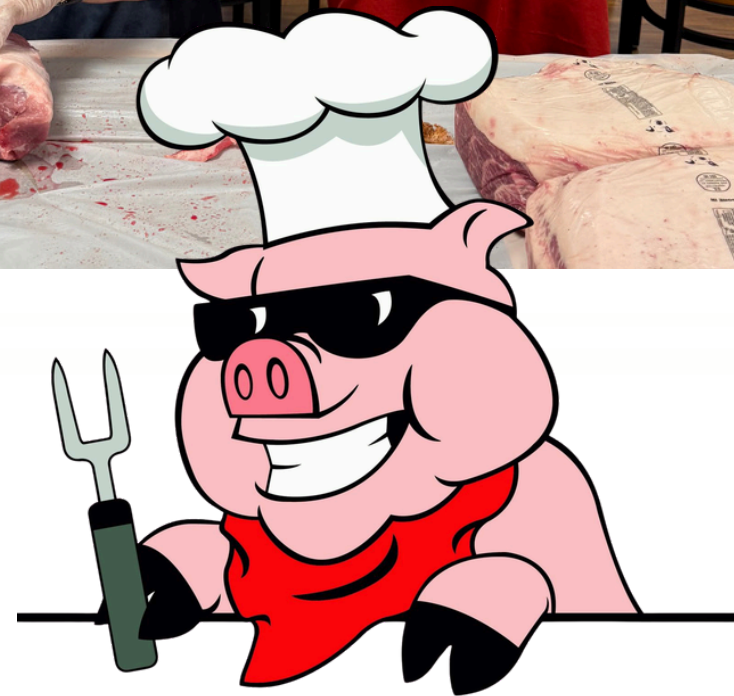
- Community Brain Injury Services serves nearly 700 survivors of brain injury annually across our services, representing a nearly 50% increase over 2 years
- CBIS is the state-designated safety-net provider for survivors of brain injury for a 26 locality service area
- In addition to our main services, CBIS engages the community with awareness, education, and outreach through a number of means. Last year, CBIS conducted over 121 Community Impact events reaching 2,117 individuals

# WHO WE SERVE OUR COMMUNITY

Experiencing a brain injury is a life-altering event that impacts the individual, the caregiver, and the entire community supporting the individual. The individuals we support are navigating the resulting lifelong disability they have as a result of their brain injury.

Community Brain Injury Services helps brain injury survivors build back independence by helping individuals set up needed supports to live independently safely, reengage with their community, return to competitive employment, and offer supports within a supportive network of peers.

## Building back lives

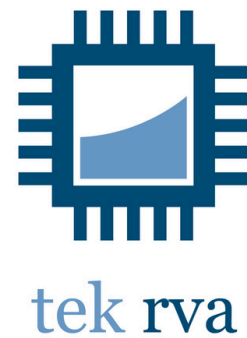
